

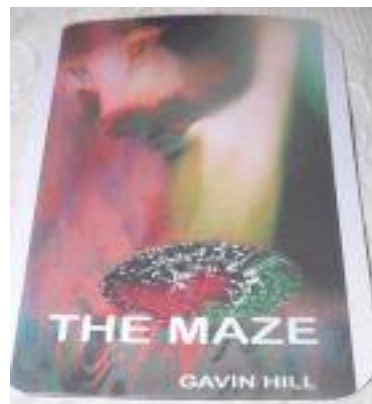
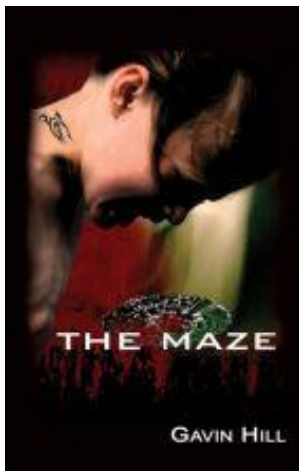

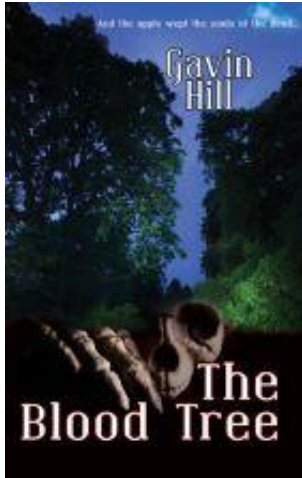

1) The time was almost in, the sun but a memory upon the horizon, night time close to taking a grip on the land

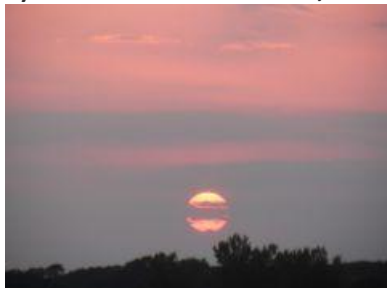

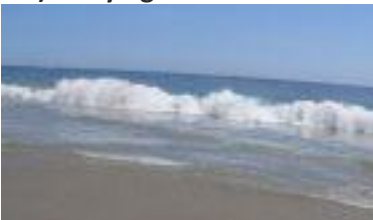
